

Q. If the panel in Carson City is not unanimous, how will the additional commissioners be brought into the voting? Will there be media coverage of the Las Vegas commissioners involved in the voting if they are brought into the hearing to vote? Who are the three commissioners in Las Vegas?

A. If during the voting process it becomes apparent that the panel will not be unanimous, the voting will be paused and the commissioners who are present in Las Vegas will be contacted. The Las Vegas Commissioners will participate in the remainder of the hearing via telephone and not video. We do not plan on hosting media in the Las Vegas office for this contingency.

A Commissioner vacancy occurred on June 30th and a new commissioner was appointed by the Governor. However, the new Commissioner will not start with the Board until after the Orenthal Simpson hearing. As such, only 6 members of the Board are available to vote on this case.

The Board has established a policy to deny parole for 6 month in the rare instance a tie vote (3-3) occurs. If a split vote occurs in this case, a subsequent hearing will be held in January 2018.
