A. <u>PURPOSE</u>:

To establish Board of Parole Commissioners (Board) procedures for court ordered sealing of records.

This policy supersedes all prior Board sealing of records policies.

B. <u>POLICY</u>:

- 1. This policy pertains to employees of the Board. For the purpose of this policy, "Board employees" include classified and unclassified employees, and non-state employees (including but not limited to contracted case hearing representatives). For independent contractors, refer to SAM 0320.0, 6.
 - a. Sealing of records and retention of sealed records shall occur in accordance with SAM 0418 and NRS Chapter 179.
 - b. All requests for sealing of records containing a sealing order from a Nevada court of record shall be submitted to the custodian of records.
 - c. The custodian of records shall gather and seal the records in the custody of the Board which relate to matters contained in a sealing order from a Nevada Court of record.
 - d. The custodian of records shall advise the Nevada court of a record in writing of compliance with the sealing order and shall then seal the sealing order pursuant to NRS 179.275(2).
 - e. The custodian of records shall not permit inspection of the sealed records unless inspection is authorized pursuant to NRS 179.301 or a court order is submitted to the custodian of records permitting the person to inspect the sealed records pursuant to NRS 179.295(1).
