The Board will review and may modify the language and instructions for the use of each of the current mitigating and aggravating factors, definitions and instructions for preparations of the NPRA and wording related to reasons and recommendations that might appear on an order granting or denying parole. Specific items under consideration include, but are not limited to, changing the instructions on when to apply the factor "nature of criminal record is increasingly more serious" and change from "juvenile conviction" references to "delinquency adjudication as a juvenile."
