## Updated Clark County Mask Requirements Effective July 22, 2021

- According to the Center for Disease Control's (CDC) guidance and the Governor's Declaration of Emergency, Directive 045, unvaccinated persons **must** still wear face coverings when outside their own homes.
- On Friday, July 16, 2021, the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) issued an updated recommendation that **both unvaccinated and vaccinated** people in Clark County wear face coverings in "crowded indoor public places where they may have contact with others who are not fully vaccinated."
- Effective July 22, 2021 through August 17, 2021, per the Clark County Commission, all employees in Clark County are required to wear face coverings when they are working indoors in public places, regardless of vaccination status, due to the increased community spread of COVID-19 in Southern Nevada.
- State agency heads have the discretion to require face coverings for all persons entering state buildings and offices, regardless of vaccination status.
