<u>Drinking Permitted:</u> You are permitted to consume alcoholic beverages but not to excess. Upon the direction of the Division of Parole and Probation, you shall submit to a medically recognized test for blood/breath content. Test results of .08 blood alcohol or higher shall be sufficient proof of excess.

<u>Substance Abuse Evaluation:</u> You shall complete a substance abuse evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

<u>No Bar Entry:</u> You shall not enter a bar or lounge, except for the purpose of employment, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.

<u>Mental Health Evaluation:</u> You shall complete a mental health evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

Mental Health Medication/Treatment Coordination: You shall not to be released on parole until mental health medication management is coordinated with a provider in the community. You shall complete a mental health evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in any treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

No Gang Contact: You shall not contact or associate with gang members and you shall not possess gang paraphernalia, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.

<u>Anger Management Program:</u> You shall enroll in an approved anger management program within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

<u>Domestic Violence Program</u>: You shall enroll in an approved domestic violence program within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

No Driving Without Approval: You shall not drive during the term of parole unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation, after presenting proof of legal authorization to drive and proof of insurance.

<u>Gambling Program</u>: You shall enroll in an approved gambling addiction program within 60 days of release from NDOC, and/or attend gambling addiction self-help meetings, until released by a qualified treatment provider or your supervising officer.

No Gambling/ No Casino Entry You shall not engage in any form of gambling, and you shall not **enter a gaming establishment**, except **for** the purpose of employment, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.

Reentry Program You shall continue to actively participate and successfully complete any reentry or judicial program prescribed by NDOC treatment program pursuant to NRS 209 & NRS 213.

<u>Judicial Program</u> You shall actively participate in and successfully complete a judicial program pursuant to NRS 209 & NRS 213.

<u>Sex Offender Compliance:</u> You shall comply with special conditions for sex offenders, and if applicable, comply with the Community Notification requirements specified in NRS 179D.475. (see attached)

Free Flow

<u>Co-Occurring Evaluation</u> You shall complete a co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorder evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

<u>ICE/Deportation Compliance:</u> You shall comply with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and follow all their instructions and reporting requirements until any deportation proceedings are completed. If you are ordered deported from the United States, you shall remain outside the United States, unless legally authorized to re-enter.
