- ~~2. ResCon NTE~~ ~~The Board directs intensive supervision pursuant to NRS 213.124 with an initial period of electronic supervision not to exceed ____ days unless extended by the Board following a written recommendation by the Chief Parole and Probation officer.~~
3. Max Supervision The Board directs the maximum level of supervision established by the Division that does not include electronic monitoring.
4. Drinking OK **Drinking Permitted:** You are permitted to consume alcoholic beverages but not to excess. Upon the direction of the Division of Parole and Probation, you shall submit to a medically recognized test for blood/breath content. Test results of .08 blood alcohol or higher shall be sufficient proof of excess.
5. Man SA eval **Substance Abuse Evaluation:** You ~~must~~ shall complete a substance abuse evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within ~~30~~ 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively ~~P~~participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
6. No Entry Bar **No Bar Entry:** You ~~are~~ shall not ~~permitted to~~ enter a bar or lounge, ~~for any purpose~~ except for the purpose of employment, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.
7. Mand MH Eval **Mental Health Evaluation:** You ~~must~~ shall complete a ~~M~~mental ~~H~~health ~~assessment~~ evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within ~~30~~ 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively ~~P~~participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
8. DNR Mental Coord **Mental Health Medication/Treatment Coordination:** ~~Inmate is~~ You shall not to be released on parole until mental health medication management ~~and treatment~~ is coordinated with a provider in the community. You shall complete a mental health evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively ~~P~~participate in any treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
- ~~9. No Victim Contact~~ ~~No Victim Contact: You may not contact or communicate with any person directly and proximately harmed by the commission of a criminal offense under any law of this State, or solicit another person to contact or communicate on your behalf with any person directly and proximately harmed by the commission of a criminal offense under any law of this State unless approved in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.~~
10. No Contact Gang **No Gang Contact:** You ~~may~~ shall not contact or associate with gang members and you ~~may~~ shall not possess gang paraphernalia, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.
- ~~11. Release through HWH~~ ~~Release only to a halfway house that specializes in the treatment for recovering alcohol and drug abusers. Duration of treatment as determined by the substance abuse treatment provider.~~
12. Enroll Anger Mgt **Anger Management Program:** You ~~must~~ shall enroll in an approved anger ~~control~~ management counseling program within ~~30~~ 60 days of release from NDOC. You ~~must actively participate in, and successfully complete any treatment as instructed by the treatment provider.~~ You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
13. Enroll Dom Vio **Domestic Violence Program:** You ~~must~~ shall enroll in an approved domestic violence counseling program within ~~30~~ 60 days of release from NDOC. You ~~must actively participate in, and successfully complete any treatment as instructed by the treatment provider.~~ You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

~~14. No Driving Period — No driving whatsoever during term of parole.~~

15. No Driv w/o app **No Driving Without Approval:** You shall not drive ~~No Driving~~ during the term of parole ~~except when~~ unless authorized in writing by ~~your supervising officer~~ the Division of Parole and Probation, after presenting proof of legal authorization to drive and proof of insurance.

16. Gambling self help **Gambling Program:** ~~Mandatory self-help attendance to address gambling addiction.~~ You shall enroll in an approved gambling addiction program within 60 days of release from NDOC, and/or attend gambling addiction self-help meetings, until released by a qualified treatment provider or your supervising officer.

17. DNE Casino/gambling **No Gambling/ No Casino Entry** ~~No gambling whatsoever, and do not~~ You shall not engage in any form of gambling, and you shall not enter a gaming establishment, ~~except for employment purposes. if employment is authorized in writing by your supervising officer.~~ the purpose of employment, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.

18. Reentry Participation **Reentry Program** You shall continue to ~~A~~ actively participate and ~~/or~~ successfully complete any reentry ~~aftercare~~ or judicial program prescribed by NDOC treatment program pursuant to NRS 209 & NRS 213.

19. Reentry Court Compliance **Judicial Program** You shall actively ~~P~~ participate in and successfully complete a ~~District Court Reentry~~ judicial program pursuant to NRS 209 & NRS 213.

21. Sex Offender **Sex Offender Compliance:** You shall ~~C~~ comply with special conditions for sex offenders, and if applicable, ~~(see attached)~~. ~~C~~ comply with the Community Notification requirements specified in NRS 179D.475. (see attached)

~~22. Warrants — You shall satisfy any outstanding warrants within 90 days of your release from custody.~~

Co-Occur **Co-Occurring Evaluation** You shall complete a co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorder evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.

ICE/Deportation Compliance **ICE/Deportation Compliance:** You shall comply with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and follow all their instructions and reporting requirements until any deportation proceedings are completed. If you are ordered deported from the United States, you shall remain outside the United States, unless legally authorized to re-enter.
