6. No Entry Bar	No Bar Entry: You are shall not permitted to enter a bar or lounge, for any purpose except for the purpose of employment, unless authorized in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.
7. Mand MH Eval	Mental Health Evaluation: You must shall complete a Mmental Hhealth assessment evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 30 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively Pparticipate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
8. DNR Mental Coor	Mental Health Medication/Treatment Coordination: Inmate is You shall not to be released on parole until mental health medication management and treatment is coordinated with a provider in the community. You shall complete a mental health evaluation and provide documented results to your supervising officer within 60 days of release from NDOC. You shall actively Pparticipate in any treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
