IV. For discussion and possible action: Review and approval of language for certain sex offender special conditions outlined in NRS 213.1245, NRS 213.1255, and NRS 213.1258 for use on future parole orders.

Chairman DeRicco opened this agenda by stating that the provided documents had been reviewed by the Deputy Attorney General. He stated he would provide an overview of the documents and then open the floor for discussion. The first document that Chairman DeRicco explained was the document titled “Pre-Masto NRS 213.1245 Conditions.” He explained these conditions would be used for any person convicted of a sexual offense defined by statute prior to February 8, 2013. He stated these conditions would be used pursuant to statute as outlined by the Masto injunction.

Chairman DeRicco then explained the second document, “Post-Masto NRS 213.1245 Conditions.” He stated these conditions would apply to offenders convicted on or after February 8, 2013. He asked the Board to view the documents side-by-side to review the differences in the two documents, Pre-Masto and Post-Masto. He stated in sections (a), (b), (g), and (q) there is a slight language change with the addition of “or her” on the Post-Masto conditions. He further explained there was a language change in section (h) and the statute was added for clarity. He continued in section (l) of the Post-Masto conditions the 500-foot rule is included as it applies to those convicted after February 8, 2013.

Chairman DeRicco opened the floor for discussion on these two documents. There was no discussion.

The third document, “NRS 213.1255 Additional Sex Offender Conditions,” was then explained by Chairman DeRicco. He stated the first section of this document includes the additional conditions for an offender who was convicted of an offense prior to February 8, 2013, against a child under the age of 14 and is a Tier 3 offender. The second section of the document includes the additional conditions for an offender who was convicted on or after February 8, 2013, against a child under the age of 14 and is a Tier 3 offender. The third section is the conditions to be imposed pursuant to statute for an offender who was convicted of a sexual offense against a child under the age of 14 but is not a Tier 3 offender. Chairman DeRicco explained the last section of this document are the additional sex offender conditions pursuant to NRS 213.1258 that are to be imposed on any cases that qualify.

He opened the floor for discussion. There was no discussion.
