

NRS 213.1255 Additional Sex Offender Conditions

Pre-Masto (Tier 3/Child Under 14) per NRS 213.1255 - As you were convicted of a sexual offense **prior to February 8, 2013**, listed in NRS 213.1255(6) against a child under the age of 14 years **and** you are a Tier 3 offender, the following **additional** conditions of parole apply:

(1)(b) As deemed appropriate by the Chief, be placed under a system of active electronic monitoring that is capable of identifying his or her location and producing, upon request, reports or records of his or her presence near or within a crime scene or prohibited area or his or her departure from a specified geographic location.

(1)(c) Pay any costs associated with his or her participation under the system of active electronic monitoring, to the extent of his or her ability to pay.

(5)(a) Participate in psychological counseling.

(5)(b) Prohibit the parolee from being alone with a child unless another adult who has never been convicted of a sexual offense is present.

Post-Masto (Tier 3/Child Under 14) per NRS 213.1255 - As you were convicted of a sexual offense **on or after February 8, 2013**, listed in 213.1255(6) against a child under the age of 14 years **and** you are a Tier 3 offender, the following **additional** conditions of parole apply:

(1)(a) Reside at a location only if the residence is not located within 1,000 feet of any place, or if the place is a structure, within 1,000 feet of the actual structure, that is designed primarily for use by or for children, including, without limitation, a public or private school, a school bus stop, a center or facility that provides day care services, a video arcade, an amusement park, a playground, a park, an athletic field or a facility for youth sports, or a motion picture theater.

(1)(b) As deemed appropriate by the Chief, be placed under a system of active electronic monitoring that is capable of identifying his or her location and producing, upon request, reports or records of his or her presence near or within a crime scene or prohibited area or his or her departure from a specified geographic location.

(1)(c) Pay any costs associated with his or her participation under the system of active electronic monitoring, to the extent of his or her ability to pay.

(5)(a) Participate in psychological counseling.

(5)(b) Prohibit the parolee from being alone with a child unless another adult who has never been convicted of a sexual offense is present.

Child Under 14 per NRS 213.1255 - As you were convicted of a sexual offense, listed in NRS 213.1255(6) against a child under the age of 14 years, the following **additional** conditions of parole apply:

(5)(a) Participate in psychological counseling.

(5)(b) Prohibit the parolee from being alone with a child unless another adult who has never been convicted of a sexual offense is present.

NRS 213.1258 Additional Sex Offender Condition

Computer/Internet Restriction per NRS 213.1258 – As you were convicted of an offense listed in NRS 213.1258(1), the following **additional** condition of parole applies:

(1) Parolee shall not own or use a computer, including, without limitation, use electronic mail, a chat room or the Internet.
