Re: Upcoming 233B.100 Hearing on 213.512

Greetings:

I heard the message, during phone conference of the 13<sup>th</sup>, that a hearing was scheduled for the above referenced matter. I have a few questions.

1. Will this meeting be covered by open-meeting law? (I hope so, obviously).
2. I requested being notified ~~at~~ <sup>by</sup> being placed on the list for notification by parole board of all regulatory meetings - will they (the executive secretary) <sup>notify me</sup> of the announcement of the hearing? (about 213.512)
3. Is it possible for me to appear by teleconference or video conference?
4. I wish to inform you that, by inadvertance I left out, at paragraph 27 at page 9 of my petition the exact citation of the NRS which conflicts with parole "law" of the "severity table" - it is 193.165.
5. a fellow named Mike Adkisson, DOC #84280 has an interest in "weighing-in" on the legal argument specific to Section II "Creates Conflicts of Law," insofar as

It relates to par. 27 at pg. 9 and NRS 193.165; in an oversimplified nutshell, 193.165 is an enhancement state found unconstitutional in a 1970's application of a Nevada District Court, and modified by the legislature to include the language to the effect that this statute does not identify a crime but an enhancement; the conflict arises when a legal fiction has to be created by NDOC to create a crime out of NRS 193.165 which directly contradicts the clear announcement it is not a crime, then applies this "crime" a number-coded severity level in the "Crime Severity Index;" at one stage NDOC created a new Category F crime just for 193.165; I've informed AdKisson I have no qualms of his sending the Commission his anecdotal evidence of his own experience and opinion about his controversy with the crime severity table alluded to in 213.512. I presume you are handling this matter and would like to be cc'd by AdKisson. If this is not true, please let me know and I will pass it along.
