All terminations of employment or program shall be immediately reported to the Division. You shall pay court ordered restitution on a monthly basis in the amount equal to the total amount of restitution owed as determined by the Division of Parole and Probation at the projected date of release on parole, divided by the number of months to be served on parole, but no less than a monthly amount of \$50.00. The total amount of restitution owed is \$ The monthly payment amount for restitution is \$ Pay all applicable fines and fees on a schedule determined by the Division of Parole and Probation. You shall not leave the state without first obtaining written permission from the Division of Parole and Probation. You shall not associate with convicted felons, persons who are engaged in criminal activity, or other persons with whom your supervising officer instructs you not to associate. Controlled substances: You shall not use, purchase or possess any illegal drugs, or any prescription drugs, unless first prescribed by a licensed.
